### Instructions

#### 1.0 Introduction

- Designed specifically for hotels and hospitality, this 0.6L kettle provides a convenient, compact solution for boiling water.
- It combines safety, ease of use, and durability, making it ideal for guest rooms.
- Please follow all safety and maintenance instructions to ensure long-lasting performance.

#### 2.0 Before First Use

- Clean the kettle by boiling a full capacity of water (0.6L) once and discarding it.
- · Wipe the exterior with a damp cloth.
- Always check that the appliance is free from visible damage before use.

#### 3.0 Important Safety Notes

### 3.1 Electrical Safety

- Ensure the voltage matches the appliance rating (220–240V).
- Do not use if the power cord or plug is damaged. If damaged, have it replaced by a qualified professional.
- Unplug the kettle when not in use or during cleaning.

#### 3.2 Operational Safety

- Always use the kettle with the provided base.
- Never operate the kettle without water inside to avoid damaging the heating element.
- Avoid overfilling to prevent water spillage during boiling.
- Keep out of reach of children under eight years old.

### 3.3 Handling Precautions

- Avoid touching hot surfaces; use the handle and lid release button.
- Do not open the lid while water is boiling to prevent scalding from steam.



- Pour boiling water slowly to reduce the risk of burns.

### **Instructions**

- To remove mineral deposits:
- Fill the kettle with 3 cups of white vinegar and enough water to cover the base. Leave overnight.
- Empty, then boil clean water to rinse thoroughly. Repeat if necessary.

### 6. Disposal

• Dispose of the kettle responsibly, adhering to local electronic waste regulations.

# **Troubleshooting**

#### 1.0 Kettle Does Not Turn On

- Check the power connection and outlet functionality.
- Ensure the power switch is free from obstructions.
- 2.0 Overheating or Automatic Shutoff
- If the kettle overheats or operates without water, it will shut off automatically.
- Allow it to cool before refilling and restarting.
- 3.0 Water Spills or Lid Issues
- Ensure the lid is securely closed during boiling.
- · Avoid overfilling the kettle.
